Glenda began her career as a nurse and has worked for over 20 years across acute and community healthcare settings. During her career Glenda managed two healthcare companies which gave her a unique blend of commercial and clinical experience, and she managed and subsequently sold a healthcare company in 2005. The experience of budgeting and staff management were very valuable, and Glenda went on to co-found another company with her current co-founder and sister, which again involved staff recruitment and healthcare. Continuing to work in the healthcare sector, she recognised that healthcare managers were burdened with time consuming paper-based systems, and set up Hygiene Audits to deliver the solution.

Hygiene Audits has received two healthcare innovation awards, a European Innovation Headstart award and most recently a Health Innovation Hub Winner 2020 award, which is supported by HSE and Enterprise Ireland.
