LawEd emerged from Kate Fleming's vision to create an educational hub that educates young people on how the law impacts their daily lives. LawEd's mission is to bring about social justice, social impact and empowerment – '*Taking the Law Further*'. The company breaks down complex legal terminology and fear to help today's young person equip themselves with essential knowledge, life skills and most importantly accountability of their actions. Kate's experience from working with over 70,000 young people is that they love learning about the law, but they do not know where to turn to for answers!

LawEd initially started out delivering workshops onsite. However, with the impact of Covid -19 on the education sector, it has now moved into delivering onsite, virtual and eLearning law courses and workshops for young people nationwide. The company has created a first of its kind in digital legal education, tailored to today's young person, through an eLearning self-directed online platform.

Kate is a duly qualified solicitor both with the Law Society of Ireland and the Law Society of England, Wales and Northern Ireland. She has also attained a Higher Diploma in Career Guidance and Counselling. She would describe herself as a mother to three children, entrepreneur, and edupreneur. She strives to create a society where everybody is educated in basic legal literacy.

Kate has also collaborated in writing and advising a pilot programme with the HSE and An Garda Síochána called the 'Inside Out' project, delivered to young people. With digital legal education at the embryonic stage, LawEd has ambitions to develop exports and launch into the UK market and further common law jurisdictions in the coming years.
