She has worked in clinical settings in both Australia and Ireland and has used her clinical expertise to create Gabadoo in order to reduce accessibility issues to allied healthcare in Ireland and abroad.

Gabadoo is a digital health platform, which streamlines the process of families accessing Occupational Therapists (OT) and Speech and Language Therapists (SLT), so families can get the support they need in as little as a few hours. Accessing child development experts such as OTs and SLTs in both the public and private system is currently taking many families months or years. OTs can support families in a wide range of areas including sensory, behaviour, motor and independence and therefore accessing these professionals is beneficial for all parents when supporting their child's development.

Since launching in Ireland in September 2022, Gabadoo has organically built its team to over 70+ therapists across Ireland and the UK and has supported hundreds of families through the platform. Gabadoo is reimagining the way families can access support for their child and their innovative approach has resulted in Gabadoo winning a Technology Ireland Industry Award and also a Digital Impact of the Year Award. In the next few months, Gabadoo is looking to expand its service across the UK, with future expansion into Australia and Canada planned.
