Maebh now leads GoPlugable as co-founder and CEO. GoPlugable is an "Airbnb for electric vehicle private chargers" that allows those who own home chargers to rent out their chargers to other EV drivers who cannot charge from home themselves due to not having a private driveway.

GoPlugable is on a mission to make the EV charging experience more convenient, accessible and affordable for all. After a year of bootstrapping from grants, pitch competitions and accelerator programs, the GoPlugable app launched in January 2024 and now hosts over 100 home charger owners.

On the journey so far, GoPlugable has received many awards such as overall winner of Catalyst Invent, Queen's University Belfast Dragons' Den and the FIA startup award. Maebh herself has been recognised as EV Pioneer of the year at the Irish EV awards 2024.

GoPlugable is currently fundraising and has goals of scaling across the GB market this year and eventually across Europe to help as many EV drivers as possible gain greater reliability in their EV charging options.
